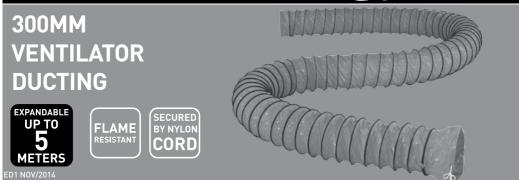

KP1004 VENTILATOR DUCTING INSTRUCTIONS UNPACKING

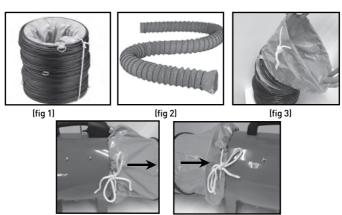
- Unpack all the components from the box.
 When unpacking the ventilator ducting hose, carefully inspect for any damage that may have occurred during transit or storage.
 Check for tears, loose parts, missing parts or damaged parts.
- 2. Ensure all packaging material is disposed of as per your local council guide lines.

ASSEMBLY

The 5 meter KP1004 ventilator ducting hose requires no assembly before fitting to a 300mm ventilation fan.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Un-tie the cord that is holding the ventilator ducting hose compressed (fig 1).
- 2. Fully extend the ventilator ducting hose (fig 2).
- Open & unfurl the quick-connect end of ducting (fig 3).
 - Note: Quick-connect end includes tie-cord.
- 4. Place the quick-connect end over either end of the ventilator fan. Note: Place the ventilator ducting hose over the air outlet (fig 4) for supplying fresh air, or over the air inlet (fig 5) for exhausting contaminated air.
- Pull tight and tie the nylon cord over the ventlator end to secure the ventilator ducting hose in place.
 Tie off securely to so that the ventilator ducting hose will not come off during use.
